



## Details/documents required for obtaining Probate of Will of the Deceased from the Hon'ble Bombay High Court

Colour photocopy of Death Certificate of the Deceased
(Original Death Certificate is required to be submitted in the Hon'ble High Court
subsequently with original Will)
Colour photocopy of Aadhar Card of the Deceased, photocopy of Aadhar Cards of all legal
heirs of the Deceased and Executors appointed under the Will
If anyone is foreign citizen, the photocopy of Passport and OCI Card
Colour photocopy of Death Certificates of pre-deceased/ since-deceased legal heirs,
Executors/s, if any
Photocopy of Aadhar Card of any one attesting witness of the Will, who will be signing
the affidavit
Current residential address of legal heirs/Executors, if the current address is different than
as mentioned in the documents
Occupation of the Deceased and all Executors
<u>Black and White</u> Photocopy of the Will of the Deceased <u>on A4 size white paper</u> . Clear
physical copy (exactly same as original Will) is a must
(Original Will is required to be submitted in Hon'ble High Court.)
Details of all available properties of the Deceased (which are yet standing in the name of
the Deceased) are required to be shown in the Schedule of Assets of Probate Petition. This
schedule is very important.

• Probate Petition to be filed in the Hon'ble Bombay High Court. Executor/s will be the main Petitioner/s. All legal heirs will have to give their consent affidavits. One Witness will also file his affidavit.

## • Court Fee

- Rs. 75,000/- (Maximum applicable)
- -Can be paid by cheque at the time of filing of petition.
